GIFT AID

Gift Aid adds a bonus to any money that you give to Friends of St Andrew's Kirk Ella Trust. If you are a UK taxpayer we can claim an extra £2.50 for each £10 that you give. Gift Aid allows any charity to claim back the tax the giver has paid on the money given.

You must have paid, or be going to pay, sufficient tax to cover your donation. The completed information is required by the Inland Revenue as your declaration that you wish the church to recover the tax. The Trust will regard your gift and declaration as confidential.

You will simply need to write your name and address and sign the form.

IMPORTANT

Please notify the Trust if you:

- Want to cancel this declaration
- Change your name or home address
- No longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains. Gift aid is linked to basic rate tax. Basic rate tax is currently 20%, which currently allows charities to reclaim 25 pence on the pound. Higher rate taxpayers can claim back the difference between basic rate and higher rate or additional rate tax.
- If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
